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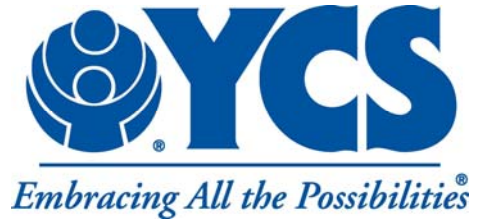

The YCS-IIC Service Program is available in Atlantic, Bergen, Burlington, Camden, Cumberland, Essex, Gloucester, Hudson, Mercer, Middlesex, Morris, Passaic, Somerset, and Union counties.

IIC Service Program

The Intensive In-community (IIC) Service Program was created to provide intensive clinical care for children with acute mental health issues and support for family members in the privacy of their own home.

YCS –IIC relies upon a variety of sensitive and family friendly therapeutic techniques to promote and restore better understanding and trust, engaging all family members in a commitment to mutual caring and support.

In-community Services

YCS clinicians work with children and families in their homes by providing services based on individualized treatment plans that includes

- Intensive counseling
- Individual therapy
- Family therapy
- Group therapy
- Play therapy
- Specialized therapy for children who are victims/survivors with sexually reactive behaviors
- Psychiatric assessment
- Cognitive behavioral interventions

IIC serves...

Families with children ages 5 -17 who are challenged by:

- **Disorders of infancy, childhood, or adolescence** (ADHD, Oppositional Defiant Disorder & Conduct Disorder)
- **Thought/psychotic disorders** (for example, young adult Schizophrenia)
- **Mood disorders** (Depressive and Bi-polar) and other behavioral or impulse control disorders
- **Co-occurring disorders** (such as a dual problem of behavior disorder and substance abuse)

YCS Clinical Staff

All clinical services are provided by highly trained, caring YCS staff that includes:

- Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSWs),
- Licensed Social Workers (LSWs)
- Licensed Professional Counselors (LPCs),
- Licensed Associate Counselors (LACs),
- Psychiatric Advanced Practice Nurses (APNs)

The IIC Service Program serves 14 counties throughout the Garden State.

Referral sources

Referrals are made to the IIC Service Program by Case Management Organizations (CMOs), Youth Case Management (YCM), Unified Case Management (UCM) and Value Options.

Following the completion of a needs assessment for each client, the referral agency will determine the duration and intensity of services on a case-by-case basis.
